Tasting Notes

The Story

The Winemakers Range of wines are typically a blend of both the Margaret River and Swan Valley wine growing regions. The riper, richer notes from the Swan Valley compliment the elegant and sophisticated flavours from the cooler climate of Margaret River. These wines are about imminent drinkability and crafted to suit a wide range of food. Or simply enjoy a chilled glass on its own.

Verdelho, Chenin Blanc & Chardonnay

Origin

Western Australia – Swan Valley & Margaret River

Vintage

The South West of Western Australia experienced below-average rainfall leading into the growing season and the warmest spring temperatures on record for Western Australia. The weather pattern remained hot and dry throughout the growing season resulting in the warmest summer on record. Flowering, version, and ripening all occurred early which led to vintage commencing two weeks earlier than normal. Harvesting occurred at optimal ripeness, and the resulting wines are full of flavour and generosity.

Winemakers Blurb

A Late harvest wine is made from grapes left on the vine for an extended period to allow for higher levels of sugar accumulation during ripening. The fruit is then harvested, crushed, chilled and pressed to tank, then allowed to settle. The racked juice then underwent a cool fermentation to protect the delicate tropical flavours and arrested early to retain a natural juicy sweetness. Well suited to lightly spiced Asian foods. Or simply enjoy on its own well chilled.

Drinking Notes

Full of passionfruit, melon and tropical fruit salad flavours, it is juicy and sweet with delicate natural acidity in balance with the sweetness. This wine was crafted to enjoy whilst fresh and youthful. Serve well chilled, or add and an ice cube or two to keep cold in the summer months.
